


The Beethoven Lives Upstairs Concert will occur on **Friday, March 6 at 7:30PM.**



**Date & Time**

The Cleveland Orchestra is performing in Severance Music Center at 11001 Euclid Avenue, Cleveland, OH 44106.



**Severance Music Center**

We will have access to the concert details and playlists so that we are able to prepare for our visit.



**Concert Details**

We will park in the parking garage off East Blvd. attached to the building.

If we need to enter through an **Accessible entrance**, we can enter through the Ticket Office doors on East Blvd.

*Pre-paid parking can be purchased in advance for \$15 from the Ticket Office. The parking rate is \$20 on concert day.*



**Parking**

We will enter the building either through sliding glass doors near the parking garage entrance, or through the lower parking level doors where we can walk up the stairs or ride the escalator. We will walk through a quick and easy security checkpoint when entering.



## Entrances

This Family Concert will include pre-concert activities beginning one hour before start time. Since the concert begins at 7:30PM, the **pre-concert activities will begin at 6:30PM.**

When we are ready to sit for the performance, helpful staff called ushers (dressed in black) will scan our tickets and help us into the concert hall.

Ushers will be stationed throughout Severance Music Center. They will guide you to your seats.



**Ushers**

We can purchase snacks and beverages from the Smith Lobby concession areas.

We will eat our snacks and any beverages other than water (with a closed top) before the concert. We can bring a closed top water bottle into the performance with us.



**Snacks & Beverages**

The Cleveland Orchestra performance will begin and the lights will be dim.

There will be a narrator to help guide us through the program during the performance with an estimated 90 orchestra musicians on the stage.



**The Orchestra**

**The conductor will enter, and the music will begin. The concert is under 60 minutes. There will be no intermission. When the one-hour concert is over, we will leave the concert hall and return to the car.**
