Bassoon Farm

The Encore Entertainment Company is Medina High School's auditioned show choir, featuring 32 singers, 13 instrumentalists, and 10 crew members. Rehearsing twice weekly outside of school, Encore competes across the Midwest and performs frequently in the community. They present a competition show, spring show, holiday show, and solo recital annually. COYO provides middle and high school students with a unique pre-professional orchestral training experience. The 2025-26 season is the 39th, led by returning conductor James Feddeck.
