



Milwaukee Rep Brings Agatha Christie's #1 Best Selling Novel to the Stage
And Then There Were None
May 26 – June 28 in the Checota Powerhouse Theater



April 22, 2026 [Milwaukee] – [Milwaukee Repertory Theater](#) closes out its inaugural season in the Associated Bank Theater Center with one of the most gripping thrillers ever written: **Agatha Christie's *And Then There Were None***, running May 26 – June 28, 2026, in the Ellen & Joe Checota Powerhouse Theater. This high-stakes production marks a major milestone in Milwaukee Rep's first season in its new home and serves as a centerpiece of the Agatha Christie Festival, a citywide celebration honoring the world's most beloved mystery writer.

Agatha Christie's heart-pounding thriller transports audiences to a secluded island full of intrigue, as ten strangers with dark secrets find themselves marooned at a grand estate, trapped in a deadly game where no one can be trusted. Christie's own acclaimed adaptation of her most famous masterpiece – the world's #1 best-selling mystery novel – is filled with suspicious twists, surprising turns and memorable characters that will keep audiences on the edge of their seat until the shocking end.
